

Post Secondary Enrollment Options Program Application Packet

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Print two copies of the Application Packet (one to be submitted and one to keep for personal records).
2. Submit a completed application by the **deadline:**
April 15 for Fall Admission
November 15 for Spring Admission
3. Submit a non-refundable application fee of \$40 made payable to BGSU (check or money order). Any future application fee to BGSU will be waived. Application received without the required fee will not be processed.
4. Provide a signed copy of the Authorization to Release Academic Information Form. (A parent/guardian is required to sign and date the form.)
5. Provide the most recent high school or junior high school official transcript which includes the cumulative grade point average. Report cards are not accepted.
6. Submit a signed copy of the high school advisement form (available from high school counselor). This form indicates that the student has received the required counseling from the high school and understands the responsibilities associated with PSEOP.
7. ***Freshmen & Sophomore applicants only:***
 - a. Submit a one page hand written essay on the following topic:
"How PSEOP participation will enrich my educational experience."
 - b. Submit a letter of recommendation from a high school guidance counselor or a teacher supporting your participation.

**Note: Freshmen & Sophomores are limited to one class per semester.*
